TONBRIDGE POWER INC. GRANTS INCENTIVE AND RETENTION OPTIONS TO INVESTOR RELATIONS CONSULTANTS AND NEW MATL EMPLOYEES

Tonbridge Power Inc. (TSXV – “TBZ”), 100% controlling shareholder of Montana Alberta Tie Ltd. (“MATL”), a company developing a transmission line project to interconnect the electricity markets of Alberta and the United States through a 300 MW transmission line between Lethbridge, Alberta and Great Falls, Montana (the “MATL Project”), announced today the granting of total of 306,000 options.

A total of 220,000 options are being issued to Brisco Capital Partners Corporation, Consultants in Investor Relations to the Corporation since 2005. These options will be issued and will vest according to TSX guidelines. A further 86,000 options are being issued to new employees, which will fully vest by October 10, 2008.

The strike price of the options being issued is \$0.316 based on the 10 day closing average trading value on April 10, 2008.
